

Whistler Trip (Dec 13-15) - IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The Whistler Ski/Snowboard Trip registration will open on Monday, October 30th at lunch . See the information letter here: <https://www.studyinsaanich.ca/students/current-students/activities>. This trip sells out very quickly, so we want to share some information to give you the best chance of getting one of the 34 spots available per school.

- The registration link will open on Monday, October 30th. It will be available on the SISP website.

- Registration is online through DC Tours. You need to pay at the time of registration to confirm your spot.
- Make sure you get permission from your natural parents now so you aren't trying to reach them in the middle of the night on Monday!.
- The cost of the trip is \$730. You will need to pay online by credit card to reserve your spot. **Please make sure that you have a credit card that can accept this charge in full.** Ask your parents if you need help!
 - The cost includes: ferry & bus transportation to and from Whistler, 2 nights accommodation in Whistler, 2 full days of skiing/snowboarding with instructor or guide, hot lunches on the mountain, ski/snowboard rentals including boots, helmet and poles.
 - The cost does not include: breakfast, lunch on day one, dinners or clothing rentals if required.
 - Lunch options: - Vegetarian/ Vegan/ Gluten Free/ Lactose Intolerant/ Nut Allergies
- You will need to provide your height, weight & [shoe size](#) (U.S) when you register (required for equipment rental).
- You will need to add your host family's name and their phone numbers as emergency contacts, so have this information ready!
- Please write NO for the required DCSA rooming share section. We will take care of room requests at school.
- You can only select one sport - you can not ski one day, snowboard the other day.
- When you are registering you will be asked "DCSA Regular or Goofy". This means:
 - Goofy - snowboarders, your right foot is in front, left foot in back
 - Regular - snowboarders, your left foot is in front, right foot in back
 - I don't know - for snowboarders who don't know if they are goofy or regular
 - I ski! - for skiers :)
- Find out if you need to rent ski clothing (pants, jackets, gloves) or if you can borrow. Clothing rentals are part of the registration process (additional fee) and are in US sizing. Clothing Rentals for the 2 days:
 - Full set (pants, jacket, gloves, goggles) = \$100
 - Jacket & Pants = \$75
 - Pants Only = \$50
 - Jacket Only = \$50
 - Gloves Only = \$25
 - Goggles Only = \$25
